With temperatures soaring to nearly 100 degrees this summer, it is important to understand the risks of extreme heat. Exposure to high temperatures can lead to heat stroke or other heat related illnesses. Heat stroke occurs when the body is unable to regulate its temperature. The body's temperature rises rapidly, the sweating mechanism fails, and the body is unable to cool down. When the body can't get rid of excess heat fast enough, the cooling system eventually breaks down, and the organs begin to overheat. If they get hot enough, they'll stop working. To prevent heat-related illness, you should take the proper precautions. Do not go out during the hottest times of the day. Spend time in a cool place. If you do not have air conditioning, go to a friend's house or to the mall. Wear loose-fitting cotton clothes. Finally, drink **LOTS** of water!

Signs of Heat – Related Illness

- Dizziness
- Fainting
- Heavy Sweating
- Muscle Cramps
- Cold/ Clammy skin
- Rapid heartbeat
- Headaches
- Nausea
